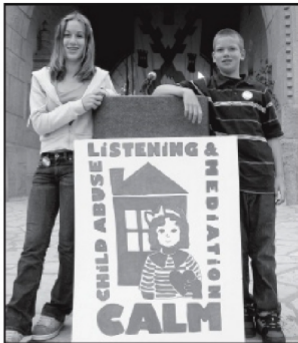


CALM offers help on bullying

With the recent rise in youth gang violence, CALM, Child Abuse Listening and Mediation, is offering useful tips for bullying prevention as well as back-to-school safety to Santa Barbara County parents. A national study (published by the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development) of over 15,000 students, grades 6 to 10, found that 19 percent of respondents had bullied others, 17 percent had been bullied, and 6 percent had both bullied others and been bullied.
